1) Stallholder Applications

A completed booking form, hand signed terms and conditions and payment must be sent to The Committee by Monday 10th July 2023 or your booking may not be accepted.

(i) Stallholders are not permitted to sell food or drinks.

2) Cancellation by the Stallholder

As the event is to raise money for our stated charities, the stall fee is non-refundable.

3) Cancellation of the Event by The Committee

In the event that The Committee is forced to cancel the event or curtail the duration of the event for any reason whatsoever, it will use its best endeavours to give as much notice as possible to Stallholders but will not accept liability for losses or costs incurred whatsoever by Stallholders arising from or in connection with the cancellation.

4) Personal Liability

Persons attending the event do so at their own risk on the strict understanding that neither The Committee nor its volunteers accept any liability for damage to or loss of property incurred on site howsoever caused.

5) Litter and Damage

Litter and other refuse must either be removed from the site or placed in the refuse sacks provided.

6) Games of Chance

Games of chance and the selling of goods by auction is strictly forbidden. Only the official Raffle Tent or The Committee are permitted to run tombolas, raffles and any other game of chance. If any Stallholder is found to be running such, they will be asked to leave the premises forthwith ceasing the Stallholder's trading opportunity without any refund of their booking fee and The Committee will not accept liability for losses or costs incurred whatsoever. Furthermore the Stallholder will not be invited back to future events.
