

GROUP TOURS TO SLEDMERE HOUSE

Admission includes exploring the House by guided tour with our experienced House stewards on hand; the group can also explore the gardens and grounds at their own leisure, either before or after the House visit.

We have ample free car and coach parking on site.

Visits can be made to the House during its opening season between June and September, or occasionally by special arrangement during the closed season.

Morning Tours (11.30am to 1.00pm)

Afternoon tours (2.00pm to 3.30pm)

You will be greeted on arrival by one of our House stewards, at The Ticket Office and will then be taken upstairs to our new conference room for an introductory talk. The party will then be divided into groups with their own guide who will take them on a House tour lasting approximately one hour. The group can then explore the gardens and grounds at their own leisure for the remainder of the day, either before or after the House tour.

GARDEN TOURS

Join our Head Gardener for a guided walk around the Walled Gardens.

Learn about their history and how, in the last few years, they have been re-developed to provide more structure and extend the season of interest - a process which is still ongoing. A great opportunity to have a look 'behind the scenes' and find out how the gardens are managed and maintained, as well as exploring the different garden rooms and looking at how plants are used to give each one its own special character. The tour will last approximately one hour.
