1. A visit to the Museum and Sledmere.

An exciting day can be put together by combining, a visit to the museum, the extraordinary Wagoners memorial monument, the Wolds wagon display, the Shire Horse Centre to see the shire horses and the adventure playground. All these are based at Sledmere House.

2. Arthur Walker's Great War.

A visit to the school by professional actor and story teller Chris Cade to tell the story of Wagner Arthur Walker's Great War.
