**Q.** Are dogs allowed in the Grounds?

**A.** Yes, on leads

**Q.** When is the Organ played?

**A.** Thursday & Sunday 1.30 pm to 3.30 pm

**Q.** Is access to Sledmere House disabled friendly?

**A.** Yes, for the most part disabled friendly. A lift is usually available for the first floor access.  
If in any doubt please contact us in advance.

**Q.** Are Wheelchairs available?

**A.** There are two manual wheelchairs. It is advisable to book them in advance of your visit

**Q.** Is parking free?

**A.** Yes, all parking is free of charge

**Q.** How far is the Car Park from the House?

**A.** The Car Park is very close to the Shop and the Café and approximately 100 metres from the House

**Q.** How far is the Coach Park from the House?

**A.** The Coach Park is opposite the main gates and is approximately 150 metres from the House

**Q.** What attractions are free to enter?

**A.** The Terrace Café, the Shop, the Wagoners' Museum, the Exhibition Room and the Triton Gallery

**Q.** Are you open on Saturdays?

**A.** No, the House & Grounds are closed on Saturdays (open Bank Holiday Saturdays)
